- 1. Call to Order. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Bartels.
- 2. Roll Call/Establishment of a Quorum.

Clint Whitney-Police Chief and Deanna Hulliger-Village Clerk,

- 4. Reading and Approval of Minutes.

Trustee Stickell motioned to approve the minutes for the Regular Board Meeting and the Executive Session held October 4, 2023. A second was given by Trustee Rigg. Ayes 6, motion carried.

5. Public Presentation/ Recognition and/or Public Comments.

Wade Argo and Sue Walters are here this evening representing the Veteran's Memorial Committee for Coal Valley. The Committee had a raffle for a fire pit basket and are here this evening to ask Mayor Bartels to draw the winning ticket. Ticket was drawn and Margie B from Rock Island is the winner. Wade and Sue talked to the board about Coal Valley residents not participating in fund raising functions and they are going to try to get more Village residents involved in future fund raisers and monument meetings. The Committee now has a Facebook page and will place information in the Village newsletter to promote the Committee and upcoming fundraisers and events.

- 6. Reports from the President and Other Officers (on matters not otherwise appearing on the agenda).
  - A. President-Mayor Bartels has nothing for this evening.
  - B. <u>Trustees-Trustee Stickell</u> drove by the Municipal Park early one evening and noticed the basketball court lights were not on. Can someone please check into this.
  - C. <u>Police</u>, <u>Public Works & Administration</u>- Chief Whitney informed the board that they have two police officer candidates that have passed background checks. They will have psychiatric exams performed soon and neither of them have been to the academy for certification. The next opportunity for class is in January 2024. The Chief will keep the board updated on the process.

Administrator Mullen reported on the following:

The owner of the property at 2001 1<sup>st</sup> Street that we have been trying to get cleaned up (and now due to vandalism needs replacement windows) stopped into the Village Hall today and informed us that he is leaving for Arizona this coming Sunday and will not be back until Spring. He hopes to sell the home next Summer. He also will have the windows boarded up before he leaves for the Winter. The Village board would like the windows checked on and the owner has had all Summer and past years to get more work done to the property. The Village needs to issue tickets on this property. Discussion was held. Administrator Mullen will relay the information to the property owner.

Fire Chief Dunham is having issues with their radio transmitter at Well #3 and after discussion with Mid-American Energy is wondering if the wires can be routed to the Village garage. Ms. Mullen explained that if any problems occur once this is done it could come back on the Village. Discussion was held. Chief Dunham will be given the answer of no on that request.

Ms. Mullen reminded the board that Trunk or Treat will be held next Tuesday, October 24, 2023 at the Municipal Park from 6:00-7:00 p.m.

We found out today that yard waste pick up will end on Wednesday, November 29th.

B. Discussion and approval of the General Liability and Workers Compensation 2024 insurance renewal through Risk Management Services.

The board reviewed the premium. Ms. Mullen stated that the cost usually goes up each year approximately 5%.

A motion was made by Trustee Jewell to approve the General Liability and Workers Compensation 2024 insurance renewal through Risk Management Services. A second to the motion was given by Trustee Mountain. Roll Call: Ayes-House, Mountain, Engstrom, Stickell, Jewell, Rigg. Ayes 6, motion carried.

C. Review, consideration and approval of a submitted bid for the E 19th Avenue curb & gutter project.

The Village board reviewed the bid results for the E. 19th Avenue project.

Trustee Engstrom made a motion to approve the bid from Walter D. Laud, Inc. in the amount of \$23,839.00 for the E 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue curb & gutter project. Trustee Jewell notices the \$250,000.00 in capital improvements earmarked for the parks, Ms. Mullen explained that is for park equipment at the Municipal Park on 1st Street.

The Board reviewed many of the funds to familiarize the newer Board members.

The banners in the budget are for banners to be displayed throughout town for holidays and such to add some festive appearance to the areas.

Safe Routes to School fund was discussed along with a grant applied for on the sidewalk for the 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue hill and stating that a retaining wall would need to be placed along E 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue hill for the sidewalk placement.

Trustee Mountain questioned the Forestview Project. There have been monies placed in the budget to continue with the Forestview/Crestview watermain project.

Discussion in general took place.

Ms. Mullen stated this will be brought back to the next meeting for approval.

E. Review, consideration and approval of the Treasurer's Report for September 2023.

The Treasurer's Report was reviewed by the board.
