Coal Valley Fire Protection District Referendum Failed

The Coal Valley Fire Protection District on the June 28th primary ballot did not pass. The question was: “Shall the maximum allowable tax rate for the Coal Valley Protection District be increased from .3% to .4% of the value of all taxable property within the district, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue?”

The Coal Valley Fire Protection District is in both Henry and Rock Island counties.
